

PLUMBERS AND DRAINERS: SCHEDULE OF FEES

Schedule of application fees established under the *Plumbing and Drainage Act 2002* (the Act) and set in *Plumbing and Drainage Regulation 2003*.

Fees are effective from 1 July 2018.

(a) For a plumber's licence or a drainer's licence (Act, s36) (Note: Cost specified is per licence)	\$139.95
(b) For a restricted licence (Act, s36) (Note: cost specified is per restricted licence)	\$86.55
(c) For a provisional licence (Act, s36) (Note: cost specified is per provisional licence)	\$64.90
(d) For an endorsement on a licence (Act, s37(a), and s7) (Note: Cost specified is per endorsement)	\$15.25
(e) To renew a licence, for each year of renewal (Act, s48)	\$73.85
(f) To renew a licence for a licensee who is an employee of a registered training organisation	\$21.65
(g) To renew a retired person's licence, for each year of renewal (Act, s48(3))	\$21.65
(h) To restore a licence (Act, s52)	\$73.85
(i) Review of licence conditions (Act, s55(3)(b))	\$64.90
(j) To replace a licence (Act, s73)	\$27.95
(k) For a qualification to be assessed for equivalence (s9)	\$27.95
2. Cost of processing an application for licence (Act, s42(3)) (Note: This is only payable once per financial year)	\$67.45
3. Certified copy of a licence (Act, s74)	\$27.95
4. Notice of notifiable work (Act, s87(3)(c))

(b) If the notice is given by a relevant entity that is a public sector entity	Nil
