GJ Bundy Pty Ltd ordered to stop work

The Commercial and Consumer Tribunal (CCT) has ordered GJ Bundy Pty Ltd to stop work at all of its building sites.

The Building Services Authority (BSA) applied to the CCT for the order after finding the company was continuing to work at a Biggenden building site despite their licence being suspended.

The CCT order was handed down late yesterday and stated GJ Bundy Pty Ltd was prohibited from performing work in the licence classes of builder low rise, carpentry and joinery.

The order applies to any building site while the company's licence is under suspension.

The CCT order gives GJ Bundy Pty Ltd 10 days to show cause why the stop work order should not be "continued in force".

BSA General Manager Ian Jennings said the authority suspended GJ Bundy Pty Ltd's three licences on 5 October 2009 for its failure to comply with a financial audit.
