BSA places condition on HIC International Constructions licence

The Building Services Authority has placed a condition on the licence of H.I.C. International Constructions Pty Ltd, which may be building in the Warwick, Emerald, Gladstone and Gold Coast areas.

The condition states that Mladen (Michael) Kljaic is a permanently excluded individual and must not be a director, secretary or influential person for H.I.C. International Constructions Pty Ltd.

BSA General Manager, Ian Jennings, said Mr Kljaic cannot control or substantially influence the conduct of the company's affairs.

He also cannot be a shareholder with a significant shareholding or financier of H.I.C. International Constructions Pty Ltd.

Mr Jennings urged anyone with evidence that Mr Kljaic had been acting as an influential person for H.I.C. International Constructions Pty Ltd to contact the BSA.

He said anyone with a complaint about non-payment issues with the company should do the same.
