## **EXTREME WORKFORCE AND EMPLOYMENT SERVICES PTY LTD LICENCE CANCELLED**

In October 2006 the Queensland Building Services Authority (BSA) suspended the licence of Mackay-based building company Extreme Workforce and Employment Services Pty Ltd (Extreme).

“We suspended the licence because the company had obtained its licence by fraud and improper means. The company also had no licensed person supervising its work and we believed the conduct of the company’s representatives and the lack of supervision of work posed a serious risk to their subcontractors and employees, consumers and suppliers,” said BSA’s general manager, Ian Jennings.

“On 16 of November we cancelled the company’s licence. Extreme, is now categorised as an excluded company and cannot operate in the Queensland building industry for five years. The company’s director, Donald Bowman, is now categorised as an excluded individual and is not able to hold a BSA licence, be a director, secretary, shareholder or influential person in a BSA-licensed company for a period of five years.

“To find out the licence status of a company, you can perform a free online licence search on BSA’s website, [www.bsa.qld.gov.au](http://www.bsa.qld.gov.au). We strongly recommend people perform an online licence search before they sign a contract for any building work,” said Mr Jennings.
