AIR-CONDITIONING AND REFRIGERATION

QBCC's licence application process supports many different pathways. The information and documentation you need to provide us to assess your application will depend on your circumstances. Below is an overview of the common pathways and the transitional arrangements that apply for the new Mechanical Services - Air - Conditioning and Refrigeration licence. <p>CONTRACTOR (UNDER \$3,300)</p> <p>You are required to hold a QBCC Trade Contractor Mechanical Services - Air - Conditioning and Refrigeration licence (limited or unlimited design) NOTE: Some work is exempt from these licensing requirements. <p>EXISTING LICENSEE</p> <p>Current licensees will be transitioned automatically to the equivalent mechanical services air conditioning and refrigeration licence class. <p>COMPANY & NOMINEE SUPERVISOR</p> <p>To provide mechanical services - air-conditioning and refrigeration services in Queensland, a company requires a QBCC Company licence and a 'nominee supervisor' for the company who has a QBCC Nominee Supervisor licence.</p> <p>Work above the value of \$3300 is already regulated under the QBCC Act 1991.</p> <p>The nominee supervisor must be an officer or employee of the company.</p>	<p>Company licence application form</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Details of the nominee • An ASIC Historical Company Extract - no older than 30 days • Financial information showing Minimum Financial Requirements are met, unless exempt • Proof of identity for at least 1 director • If you have a trading name for your business you can provide this with your application <p>Nominee Supervisor</p> <p>Individual - trade contractor licence application form</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Experience if required • Documents showing technical qualifications • A certificate of completion of a QBCC approved managerial course • Proof of identity 	<p>MUST HOLD LICENCE BY:</p> <p>1 JULY 2020</p>
<p>SITE SUPERVISOR</p> <p>A site supervisor licence allows an employee or officer of a licensed contractor to supervise building work under the contractor's licence.</p>	<p>Site Supervisor licence application form</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Documents showing technical qualifications • Proof of identity 	<p>MUST HOLD LICENCE BY:</p> <p>1 JANUARY 2022</p>
<p>EMPLOYEE</p> <p>From 1 January 2022, you will need a QBCC mechanical services occupational licence to continue performing mechanical services air conditioning and refrigeration work as an employee.</p> <p>If you don't have qualifications for the work you currently perform as an employee, you will need to gain them or have your current skills recognised by a Registered Training Organisation (RTO).</p>	<p>Occupational licence application form</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Evidence of technical qualifications or if you don't hold the technical qualifications you may be eligible for Recognition of Prior Learning (see below) • Proof of identity <p>Alternative Qualification Pathway</p> <p>Until 30 September 2021 you can submit an application for an occupational licence using the alternative qualification pathway, where experience may be recognised as an alternative to technical qualifications. For more information go to our website.</p>	<p>MUST HOLD LICENCE BY:</p> <p>1 JANUARY 2022</p> <p>The alternative qualification pathway closes 30 September 2021</p>

Do you have experience without qualifications?

If you have experience but you don't hold the required technical qualifications, you should consider skills assessment. You may be eligible for Recognition of Prior Learning.
