Maryborough now has access to all the Queensland Building Services Authority (BSA) has to offer after the local office was expanded recently in response to the area's building boom.

Over 5 per cent of BSA's 69,500 licencees live and work in the Maryborough region, all of whom now have access to more comprehensive building advice and services.

Since 2001, building activity in the Widebay-Burnett region has almost doubled, and there are no signs of slowdown with more than 6,200 jobs insured in the area by BSA last financial year.

Residents and licencees will all benefit from the increase in offered services, with the office providing licencing, dispute management and resolution, home warranty insurance and customer services.

The Maryborough office, situated on Lennox Street, was previously just a satellite office of the Sunshine Coast offering limited services.

BSA General Manager Ian Jennings said residents and licencees were welcome to visit the office to speak to one of the BSA's four staff about any building matters.

"The BSA's Maryborough team is led by Mick Rendell, who has 40 years' experience in the building industry and holds an Open Builder licence," Mr Jennings said.
