BSA suspends licence of Mybelle Homes Pty Ltd

On 17 October BSA suspended the licence of Mybelle Homes Pty Ltd (Mybelle) over concerns that serious financial and other harm could occur to consumers, employees, sub-contractors and suppliers if the company continued trading.

BSA General Manager Ian Jennings said the company has about 13 homes under contract in the Townsville area.

“BSA’s investigations indicate the company has approximately 13 contracts on foot in the Townsville area, construction on some of which is yet to commence.

“BSA’s investigations were triggered by a complaint from a consumer that Mybelle was taking an unusually long time to complete building work.

“After speaking to other consumers contracted to Mybelle about the progress of their building work, BSA suspended Mybelle’s licence as it believed serious financial and other harm could be suffered by subcontractors, suppliers, and consumers if the company were to continue trading,” said Mr Jennings.

“BSA staff have informed all owners of the licence suspension via telephone and will send each consumer a letter outlining their entitlements under BSA’s Home Warranty Insurance Scheme.

“BSA has also personally met with some consumers in Townsville this week to discuss what possible assistance BSA can offer them.”
