Regulatory Impact Statement - *Queensland Building Services Authority Regulation 2003*

A Regulatory Impact Statement has been prepared on proposed amendments to the *Queensland Building Services Authority Regulation 2003*. The primary objectives of the proposed legislation are to ensure:

- (a) that the BSA continues to provide Queensland consumers and home owners with a financially viable home warranty insurance scheme into the future which provides the most comprehensive cover and cost effective premium structure; and
- (b) the technical qualifications required for a *Termite management – physical licence* under the *Queensland Building Services Authority Act 1991* are consistent with the Australian Qualifications Framework and to improve standards and the quality of work performed by persons who hold such licences.

The purpose of the Regulatory Impact Statement is to consult on and explain the need for, and details of, the proposed legislation and present the likely costs and benefits that would flow from its adoption in comparison with other options.
