



QUEENSLAND BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION COMMISSION

In 2019, the Integrity and Complaints Branch of the QBCC undertook an internal audit of the Commission’s Gifts and Benefits policy and procedures. Amongst the recommendations arising from the audit, was that the QBCC would commit to placing a greater emphasis on reporting requirements, as of 1 July 2019. These revised reporting requirements now place a greater obligation on all staff to declare all gifts and benefits and includes quarterly publications of gifts and benefits that were offered, retained or declined for items below and above \$150.

In pursuit of greater integrity and transparency across the QBCC, the quarterly report provides a comprehensive view of reportable gifts and benefits offered to the QBCC and its staff.
