

# Industry Advisory Committee expression of interest

## Expression of interest now open for the Industry Advisory Committee

The Queensland Building and Construction Commission (QBCC) is seeking expressions of interest from suitably qualified applicants to join the QBCC Industry Advisory Committee (Committee).

The purpose of the Committee is to provide observations, strategic advice, and guidance to the QBCC Board (the Board) in relation to matters affecting the building and construction industry to achieve a reasonable balance between the interests of building industry practitioners and consumers.

## The role of the Committee

The role of the Committee is to provide a forum for the Board to formally engage with the building and construction industry, providing advice, guidance and making recommendations to the Board based on:

- industry expertise on current issues relating to the building and construction industry
- emerging risks and trends affecting the building and construction industry
- matters relevant to the sector
- promoting the QBCC's regulatory activities.

## Representatives for the Committee

We are seeking representatives from the following sectors. It is acknowledged that there may be one or more member(s) appointed for each sector:

- Mechanical Services
- Consumers/homeowners (representing consumers rights and interests).

Where a representative of a sector involves a professional trade, it is desirable that the representative either holds a valid licence or have previously held a valid licence or be eligible to hold a licence. Please note this is a voluntary role, providing a unique opportunity to represent and advise on issues of importance for the Queensland building and construction industry.

## What you need to know

The following applies for those applying for memberships to the Committee:

- The EOI will remain open for 2 weeks and close at 5:00pm, 26 April 2024.

- A short response (maximum 2 pages) on how your experience, abilities, knowledge, and personal qualities would enable you to represent your industry sector and how you will contribute to the purpose of the role.
- A current CV and two (2) referees. Referees will only be contacted with your consent.

- Members of the Committee will be appointed following the expression of interest process overseen by the QBC Board.
